Dr Amy Orr-Ewing is an international author, speaker and theologian who addresses the deep questions of our day with meaningful answers found in the Christian Faith. Travelling internationally Amy is a regular speaker across university campuses, businesses, parliaments, churches and conferences as well as on TV, radio and podcasts. She holds a DPhil (PhD) in Theology from the University of Oxford and is the author of multiple publications and books including 'Where is God in All the Suffering?' (runner up Michael Ramsay Prize, 2023), bestselling 'Why Trust the Bible?' and 'Mary's Voice: Advent Reflections to Contemplate the Coming of Christ.'

In 2023, Amy was awarded the Alphege Medal for Evangelism and Witness by the Archbishop of Canterbury. She previously served as President of the Oxford Centre for Christian Apologetics and is now Honorary Lecturer at the School of Divinity, University of Aberdeen, Distinguished Scholar at Wheaton College Illinois and Theologian in Residence at Saint in Hackney, London.
